Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Coral Bay Recreation Center.

Attendance in person were; Liza Smoker, District Counsel; Jonathan Geiger, District Engineer; Andrew Gill, GMS; Mr. Nick Caine, CV Pro Lighting; Mauro Cruz, Your Maintenance Partners, Robert McCormick, resident and several residents in attendance in any format.

1. Roll Call and Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Hall called the meeting to order. (Tape Time: 0:02:24)

2. Presentations/Reports

Mr. Gill (Tape Time: 0:03:12) stated there was a presentation for Christmas lighting from Your Maintenance Partners. Mr. Gill then provided the Board with the proposal from Your Maintenance Partners.

(At this time (Tape Time: 0:03:28) Mr. Cruz from Your Maintenance Partners gave a short presentation and presented his proposal to the Board in the amount of \$18,700 for holiday lighting 2025, with an additional \$12,500 for the Christmas package, and \$85 for maintenance calls)

(A Q&A session (Tape Time 0:05:53) was held among the Board members, Mr. Padilla, and Mr. Cruz relating to his proposal)

Mr. Gill (Tape Time: 0:14:03) stated there was also a presentation from Nick Caine from CV Pro Lighting and his proposal was included in the agenda package.

(At this time (Tape Time: 0:14:11) Mr. Caine from CV Pro Lighting gave a short presentation and presented his proposal to the Board in the amount of \$32,190. He stated they tried to meet last year's proposal apples to apples except for adding the additional lighting of palm fronds that the Board had requested which was included in both proposals)(He then made a few additional comments relating some details on the scope of work)

(A Q&A session (Tape Time 0:15:30) was held among the Board members, Mr. Padilla, Mr. Gill and Mr. Caine relating to his proposal)

3. Audience Comments / Supervisors Comments

Mr. Hall asked if there were any audience comments or Supervisor's comments at this time. (Tape Time: 0:36:51)

Mr. McCormick (Tape Time: 0:36:59) asked a couple of questions relating to the holiday lighting and made a few additional comments relating to unsolicited flyer advertising packets being distributed around the community.

(At this point (Tape Time: 0:38:23) a discussion was held among the Board members and staff relating to Mr. McCormick's statements)

A resident (Tape Time: 0:39:17) from Las Brisas also made a few comments relating the unsolicited papers around the community, stating that they were being left on the ground on driveways and in front of resident entryways, creating an eyesore. She also made some additional comments relating to receiving a notice that she's no longer allowed to have her chairs on her driveway.

(At this point (Tape Time: 0:40:21) a discussion was held among the Board members relating to the resident's statements)(The Board informed the resident that she would need to speak directly to her HOA manager as this was not a CDD matter)

Another resident (Tape Time: 0:43:25) made a few comments relating fishing in the lake and people leaving their garbage on North Bay Drive and South Bay Drive, between water fountains, which was getting out of control.

(At this point (Tape Time: 0:44:00) a discussion was held among the Board members and the resident relating to his statements) (Mr. Hall informed the resident that Mr. Padilla will follow up on the matter)

Mr. Hall asked if there were any other audience or Supervisor comments at this time. (Tape Time: 0:45:40) (There were no other comments)

4. Item(s) for Board Consideration A. Update on Lake Maintenance Easement Letters and Responses

Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 0:45:44) moved on to item No. 4A, update on lake maintenance easement letters and responses and asked Mr. Gill to present this item.

Mr. Gill (Tape Time: 0:45:54) gave a brief update stating that at the last Board meeting, he went over the status of the certified letters which were sent to the 37 residents located on the lake, and he was now starting to receive calls and responses from those residents. He also made a few additional comments stating that 15 of those had responded or already had CDD approval, and he was still waiting for responses from the remaining residents who have until the end of August before the 30-period ends to respond.

(At this point (Tape Time: 0:46:39) a discussion was held among the Board members, Mr. Gill, and Ms. Smoker relating to this item)(Mr. Hall suggested (Tape Time: 0:47:31) sending a demand letter to the remaining 21 residents who had not responded to remove whatever is in the lake easement area and give them 15 days to comply) Ms. Smoker (Tape Time: 0:48:34) stated at the last meeting the Board agreed to give the residents 30 days, and also add 5 days for mailing purposes as a courtesy to make sure everyone received the letter)

Mr. Gill (Tape Time: 0:55:33) asked the Board for a motion to authorize the District Manager to draft an additional letter to all remaining homeowners who have not responded demanding they remove the items that are in the lake easement area.

Mr. Padilla (Tape Time: 1:06:43) stated he had an additional item for the Board's consideration relating to a public concern of some trees on CDD property very close to the water line along Orinoco Lane, that could cause an issue with clogging the drainage system during a major storm event. Mr. Padilla also stated he had obtained some proposals for removing those trees in two sections, one from Just Call James for \$5,200, another one from Shinto Landscaping to do the same scope of work, and also another proposal to remove trees on CDD property. Mr. Padilla then asked for direction from the Board as to how to proceed.

(At this point (Tape Time: 1:08:05) a discussion was held among the Board members, Mr. Padilla and Mr. Geiger relating to this item)

B. Update on Major Projects List

Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 1:12:26) moved on to item No. 4B update on major projects list and asked Mr. Padilla if there was anything different on the list from last month.

Mr. Padilla (Tape Time: 1:12:50) gave a brief update relating to a couple of items on the major projects list that had been updated.

(At this point (Tape Time: 1:13:53) a discussion was held among the Board members, Mr. Gill and Mr. Padilla relating to this item)(Ms. Hagen (Tape Time: 1:16:07) gave a brief overview on a few items listed on the major projects list, such as the tennis courts, the docks, etc. to the attending audience)

C.CV Pro Lighting Proposal Modifications

Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 1:29:39) moved on to item No. 4C, CV Pro Lighting proposal modifications and stated this item had already been presented and discussed earlier in the meeting.

5. Discussion of Canal Bank Erosion Control Options

Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 1:40:26) moved on to item No. 5A discussion of canal bank erosion and asked Mr. Gill to present this item.

Mr. Gill (Tape Time: 1:11:06) gave a brief update on this item stating they were still in ongoing discussions with Mr. Geiger and would bring this item back to the next Board meeting. He also stated part of this item had to do with the trees being removed along the canal on the property owner's side and Mr. Padilla would be addressing how they would deal with the erosion along the canal bank.

Mr. Geiger (Tape Time: 1:41:15) also made a few additional comments related to this item stating he was asked to provide some information to GMS in terms of a cost to survey the canal on the District's property regarding the erosion control to see if anything

needed to be done now. He stated they were good shape on the north and south ends of the canal bank with very little erosion, and since no residents live at that end of the canal, that could be a repair as needed item.

(At this point (Tape Time: 1:41:47) a discussion was held among the Board members and staff relating to this item)

6. Staff Reports

Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 1:46:12) then moved on to staff reports and asked Ms. Smoker for her report.

A. Attorney – Memorandum - 2025 Legislative Update

Ms. Smoker (Tape Time: 1:46:18) gave a brief update on the 2025 legislative update memorandum that was included in the agenda, specifically the ones that pertain to Special Districts relating to the rulemaking process and notices, and change orders for construction work as well.

(At this point (Tape Time: 1:47:35) a Q&A session was held among the Board members and Ms. Smoker relating to this item)

B. Engineer

Mr. Hall (*Tape Time: 1:49:28*) moved on to the engineer and asked Mr. Geiger for his report.

Mr. Geiger (Tape Time: 1:49:30) gave a brief update stating most of the items he was working had already been discussed during the meeting in other conversations, and the only thing he had relating to permit review was the deck at 6688 Buena Vista Drive, but he had still not received the application from the resident. He did inform the resident that her deck was in the easement and also made it very clear to the homeowner that it was shown on her survey, so he was awaiting to review that.

He also stated he was working on some of the items for the bond issue, including the roadway inspections and the pavement marking and striping which needed to be done.

(At this point (Tape Time: 1:51:21) a discussion was held among the Board members and Mr. Gieger relating to his report)(Mr. Hall (Tape Time: 1:53:08) asked Mr. Geiger for an update on the docks) (Mr. Geiger stated there was a change order if the Board wanted to go over that but, Broward County had required design changes to comply with code regulations for the permit, so the change order was to address the drawing revisions)

Mr. Padilla (Tape Time: 1:53:53) stated this item was under the field manager's report but, he would bring it up on the screen for the Board members to review. He then gave a brief update on the change order for additional materials in the amount of \$8,933.
